AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 92

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, before "Mental" insert "Health and"; in line 9, after "directors;" insert "providing that certain funds paid by local jurisdictions for certain services are to be credited toward certain funds payable for residential, day habilitation, and vocational services; defining a certain term; providing for the application of this Act;"; in line 10, strike "the" and substitute "health and"; and in line 13, after "Section" insert "7-705.".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, after line 18, insert:

"7-705.

(A) IN THIS SECTION, "LOCAL FUNDS" INCLUDES PAYMENTS MADE BY A LOCAL JURISDICTION FOR RESIDENTIAL, DAY HABILITATION, OR VOCATIONAL SERVICES.

(B) For day habilitation and vocational services, the Administration shall also use local funds. The local funds shall be limited to the amount paid by each jurisdiction in fiscal year 1984.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health - General".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 5, after line 32 insert:

(Over)

“SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act shall be construed retroactively and shall be applied to and interpreted to affect all fiscal years beginning on or after July 1, 1986. The Department of Health and Mental Hygiene shall credit any payments made by a local jurisdiction for residential, day habilitation, or vocational services for individuals with developmental disabilities toward any amount due under § 7-705 of the Health - General Article.”;

and in line 33, strike “2.” and substitute “4”.
