AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 514

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, after "Districts -" insert "Periodic Review -"; in line 3, after the first "of" insert "requiring the General Assembly to review the desirability of continuing the existence of certain community benefits district management authorities under certain circumstances; providing for the termination of a community benefits district management authority that the General Assembly does not approve under certain circumstances;"; in line 5, after "districts" insert "; and generally relating to the periodic review and continuation of authority of community benefits districts in Baltimore City".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 36, strike "(j)" and substitute "(K)".

On page 5, in line 1, strike "(i)" and substitute "(J)"; after line 19, insert:

"(H) (1) BEGINNING WITH THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN 2000, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL REVIEW EVERY 4 YEARS THE DESIRABILITY OF CONTINUING THE EXISTENCE OF EACH COMMUNITY BENEFITS DISTRICT MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SECTION.

(2) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, IF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY DOES NOT APPROVE THE CONTINUING EXISTENCE OF A COMMUNITY BENEFITS DISTRICT MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY, THE COMMUNITY BENEFITS DISTRICT SHALL CEASE TO EXIST AT THE END OF THE CITY'S FISCAL YEAR IN WHICH APPROVAL WAS NOT GRANTED.

(3) THE COMMUNITY BENEFITS DISTRICT MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY SHALL CONTINUE ITS EXISTENCE ONLY AS LONG AS NECESSARY TO TERMINATE

(Over)

OPERATIONS IN A REASONABLE FASHION AND TO ARRANGE FOR THE DISPOSITION OF ALL FUNDS NOT NEEDED TO SATISFY OUTSTANDING OBLIGATIONS AND RESERVES FOR UNCERTAIN OBLIGATIONS AND LIABILITIES.”;

and in lines 20, 23, and 25, strike “(h)”, “(i)”, and “(j)”, respectively, and substitute “(I)”, “(J)”, and “(K)”, respectively.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 5, in line 33, strike “7” and substitute “6”; and in line 34, strike “2001” and substitute “2000”.
