On page 29, in line 37, after "That" insert "<u>on or before October 1, 1998, the Department of</u> Assessments and Taxation shall adopt regulations applicable to the taxable year beginning July 1, 1999 to adjust the valuation of use-valued property in a manner that would be revenue neutral relative to this Act. Notwithstanding § 8-104(b) of the Tax - Property Article, the Department shall revalue all use-valued property for the date of finality January 1, 1999 pursuant to the adjusted use valuation rates.
