AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 795, AS AMENDED

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 2 of the bill, in line 46, after the second "Act;" insert "<u>requiring that a certain question be placed on the ballot in Baltimore City at the November general election of 1999 so as to determine the sense of the voters on the issue in question; providing for the powers and duties of <u>certain Baltimore City officials;</u>".</u>

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 14 of the Appropriations Committee Amendments (SB0795/784636/1), in line 14 of Amendment No. 9, after the period insert:

"SECTION 30. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That under the provisions of Article 33 - Election Code, Section 16-6 and Section 23-1(a) of the Annotated Code of Maryland, the Board of Supervisors of Elections of Baltimore City and the Treasurer of Baltimore City shall prepare and include on the ballot for the Baltimore City November general election of 1999 the following question:

"Do you favor in Baltimore City that the members of the New Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners be elected by the citizens of Baltimore City?"

SECTION 31. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Board of Supervisors of Elections of Baltimore City, the Treasurer of Baltimore City, and the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore shall do those things necessary and proper to place the question required under Section 30 of this Act on the ballots or voting machine labels prepared for the Baltimore City November general election of 1999, so that each participating voter in Baltimore City may have an opportunity to cast a vote on the question. The question shall be proposed, presented, tallied, and reported in general accordance with the provisions of Article 33 of the Annotated Code. The vote on this question is advisory only.";

and in line 15 of Amendment No. 9, strike "30." and substitute "32.".
