AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 796

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with “authorizing” in line 8 down through “law;” in line 10; and in line 14, strike “17-202.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 1 and 2, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 20 on page 1 through line 13 on page 2, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 15 through 26, inclusive, and substitute:

“(A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, EACH CONTRACTOR AND SUBCONTRACTOR UNDER A PUBLIC WORK CONTRACT SHALL PAY NOT LESS THAN THE PREVAILING WAGE RATE FOR EACH HOUR WORKED.

(B) A CONTRACTOR AND SUBCONTRACTOR SHALL PAY AN EMPLOYEE THE PREVAILING WAGE RATE OF OVERTIME FOR EACH HOUR THE EMPLOYEE WORKS:

(1) IN EXCESS OF 10 HOURS IN ANY SINGLE CALENDAR DAY;

(2) IN EXCESS OF 40 HOURS PER EACH WORKWEEK; OR

(3) ON SUNDAY OR A LEGAL HOLIDAY.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 3, in line 1, strike “SUBJECT TO § 10-1001 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.”; and in line 3, strike “UP TO”.
