AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 317

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike "Power Dredging of"; in line 8, after "oysters;" insert "establishing a certain oyster sanctuary in Somerset County; prohibiting the catching of oysters from the oyster sanctuary; providing for the review and termination of certain provisions of this Act; "; and in line 8, strike the second "power dredging" and substitute "the catching".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 38, insert:

"SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

4-1014.

(G) (1) THERE IS AN OYSTER SANCTUARY IN THE AREA KNOWN AS THE WEBSTER GROUND THAT INCLUDES ALL THE WATERS INSHORE OF A LINE NORTHEASTERLY FROM LONG POINT TO LATITUDE 38 DEGREES, 12.63 MINUTES AND LONGITUDE, 75 DEGREES, 51.85 MINUTES, A DESIGNATED POINT IN MONIE BAY, THEN SOUTHWESTERLY TO THE EASTERN ENTRANCE TO PIGEON HOUSE CREEK.

(2) A PERSON MAY NOT CATCH OYSTERS IN THE OYSTER SANCTUARY DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

<u>SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Department of Natural</u> Resources, in consultation with the Tidal Fish Advisory Committee, shall review the location of the

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oyster sanctuary established under Section 2 of this Act and make a recommendation to the General Assembly by January 1, 2001 as to whether the oyster sanctuary should be continued for an additional 5 years. ".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, in line 1, strike "2." and substitute "4."; and in line 2, after "1997." insert "Sections 2 and 3 of this Act shall remain effective for a period of 4 years and, at the end of September 30, 2001, with no further action required by the General Assembly, Sections 2 and 3 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect. ".
