AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 488  
(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike in its entirety line 2 and substitute "Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System - Membership"; in line 5, after "exceptions;" insert "requiring individuals for whom membership in the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System is optional to apply for membership by filing a written application with the State Retirement Agency on or before a certain date; prohibiting those individuals from becoming members on or after a certain date;"; strike beginning with "of" in line 5 down through "officers" in line 6.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 19, strike "Membership" and substitute:

"(1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, MEMBERSHIP";

in line 20, strike "who was employed"; in lines 21, 22, and 23, strike "(1)", "(2)", and "(3)", respectively, and substitute "(I) WHO WAS EMPLOYED", "(II) WHO WAS EMPLOYED", and "(III) WHO WAS EMPLOYED", respectively; in line 21, after "1990" insert "AND WHO ELECTS MEMBERSHIP ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 1997"; in line 22, after "1995" insert "AND WHO ELECTS MEMBERSHIP ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 1997"; in line 24, after "1997" insert "AND WHO ELECTS MEMBERSHIP ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 1997"; after line 24, insert:

"(2) TO ELECT TO BE A MEMBER OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM, AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL FILE A WRITTEN APPLICATION WITH THE STATE RETIREMENT AGENCY.

(3) IF AN INDIVIDUAL DOES NOT ELECT MEMBERSHIP DURING THE APPLICABLE PERIOD SPECIFIED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT BECOME A MEMBER OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM."
