A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Highways - Harriet Tubman Memorial Bridge**

3 FOR the purpose of naming the U.S. Route 50 bridge across the Nanticoke River in the  
4 vicinity of Vienna, Maryland the "Harriet Tubman Memorial Bridge".

5 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

6 Article - Transportation

7 Section 8-649

8 Annotated Code of Maryland

9 (1993 Replacement Volume and 1996 Supplement)

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Article - Transportation**

13 8-649.

14 (A) The new bridge across the Choptank River in the vicinity of Cambridge shall  
15 be named the Senator Frederick C. Malkus, Jr. Bridge.

16 (B) THE U.S. ROUTE 50 BRIDGE ACROSS THE NANTICOKE RIVER IN THE  
17 VICINITY OF VIENNA, IDENTIFIED AS ITEM 09022 IN THE ADMINISTRATION'S BRIDGE  
18 INVENTORY, SHALL BE NAMED THE HARRIET TUBMAN MEMORIAL BRIDGE.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
20 October 1, 1997.
