- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article Labor and Employment
- 14 9-607.
- 15 (a) The Commission may not award compensation to a prisoner who is a covered
- 16 employee under § 9-221 of this title until the prisoner is discharged by pardon, parole, or
- 17 expiration of sentence.
- 18 (b) If a prisoner WHO IS A COVERED EMPLOYEE UNDER § 9-221 OF THIS TITLE
- 19 dies from an accidental personal injury, the dependents of the prisoner are entitled to
- 20 compensation under this title, based on the average weekly wage of the prisoner.
- 21 (C) IF AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS AWARDED BENEFITS UNDER THIS TITLE
- 22 BECOMES INCARCERATED, THE INDIVIDUAL IS NOT ENTITLED TO BENEFITS AND
- 23 BENEFITS MAY NOT ACCRUE DURING THE PERIOD OF INCARCERATION.
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 25 October 1, 1997.
