3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the making of a tattoo on a minor except under certain

- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article 27 Crimes and Punishments
- 14 MINORS TATTOOS

16 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "TATTOO" MEANS A DESIGN OR MARK MADE ON THE 17 SKIN BY:

18 (1) PIERCING THE SKIN AND INGRAINING IN IT AN INDELIBLE PIGMENT;19 OR

## 20 (2) RAISING SCARS ON THE SKIN.

(B) A PERSON MAY NOT MAKE A TATTOO ON A MINOR UNLESS A PARENT OR22 GUARDIAN OF THE MINOR CONSENTS TO THE TATTOO.

23 (C) (1) IN THE PROSECUTION FOR A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION, IT SHALL24 BE A DEFENSE THAT THE DEFENDANT USED DUE CAUTION TO DETERMINE THAT:

25 (I) THE TATTOO RECIPIENT WAS AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD AT THE 26 TIME OF THE TATTOO; OR

# 1 (II) A PARENT OR GUARDIAN CONSENTED TO THE TATTOO.

2 (2) THERE IS A PRESUMPTION OF DUE CAUTION IF:

3 (I) THE DEFENDANT EXAMINED THE TATTOO RECIPIENT'S
4 DRIVER'S LICENSE OR OTHER VALID IDENTIFICATION ISSUED BY AN EMPLOYER, A
5 GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY, OR INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION; AND

6 (II) THE IDENTIFICATION POSITIVELY IDENTIFIED THE TATTOO 7 RECIPIENT AS AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD.

8 (D) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR9 AND SHALL BE SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$5,000.

10 (E) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, EACH SEPARATE AND DISTINCT 11 INCIDENT AT A DIFFERENT TIME AND OCCASION IS A SEPARATE VIOLATION.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 1997.
