3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Lottery Agency to withhold certain amounts from certain lottery prizes from certain individuals who have received public assistance benefits; requiring the Department of Human Resources to certify to the State Lottery Agency the name of any individual who received certain public assistance benefits within a certain period; providing for the procedure to be followed in withholding amounts from lottery prizes; providing for the priority of lottery prize interception requests; authorizing the Secretary of Human Resources and the Director of the State Lottery Agency to adopt certain regulations; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the payment of State lottery prizes.
