- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing that the Workers' Compensation Commission retains
- 4 jurisdiction over certain matters in a case under certain circumstances; and

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 Article - Labor and Employment

14 9-742.

(a) The Commission retains jurisdiction pending an appeal to consider a requestfor additional medical treatment and attention.

17 (b) If the Commission finds that a covered employee needs additional medical 18 attention pending an appeal, the Commission may pass a supplemental order requiring 19 the employer to provide additional medical treatment and attention.

20 (c) A supplemental order passed by the Commission under this section is subject 21 to review on the pending appeal. 2

(D) WHEN AN APPEAL THAT IS PENDING RELATES SOLELY TO A PENALTY
IMPOSED BY THE COMMISSION, THE COMMISSION RETAINS JURISDICTION OVER ALL
MATTERS IN THE CASE OTHER THAN IMPOSITION OF THE PENALTY.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 1997.
