- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 24 A HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION IS LIABLE IN A CIVIL ACTION FOR

- 26 FAILURE TO APPROVE A COVERED SERVICE OR BENEFIT IF THE SERVICE OR
