- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article Insurance
- 15 19-511.1.
- 16 (A) IN AN ACTION FOR DAMAGES IN CIVIL COURT BROUGHT BY AN INSURED
- 17 AGAINST AN INSURER ARISING UNDER THE INSURED'S UNINSURED MOTORIST
- 18 COVERAGE OR AGAINST AN UNINSURED MOTORIST, THE INSURER MAY NOT ENTER
- 19 A DEFENSE OR INTERVENE ON BEHALF OF THE UNINSURED MOTORIST.
- 20 (B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PREVENT AN INSURER FROM OTHERWISE
- 21 RAISING A DEFENSE ON ITS OWN BEHALF RELATED TO THE EXISTENCE OR AMOUNT
- 22 OF A CLAIM.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 24 October 1, 1997.
