- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article 88A Department of Human Resources
- 14 55.
- 15 WHEN A RECIPIENT'S DEPENDENT CHILD IS REQUIRED TO ATTEND SCHOOL
- 16 UNDER § 7-301 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE, A GRANT OF ASSISTANCE UNDER THE
- 17 FAMILY INVESTMENT PROGRAM SHALL BE SUBJECT TO A \$5 PENALTY REDUCTION
- 18 OF A SUBSEQUENT MONTHLY ASSISTANCE PAYMENT FOR:
- 19 (1) EACH SCHOOL DAY OF AN ASSISTANCE PAYMENT MONTH THAT THE
- 20 DEPENDENT CHILD IS ABSENT FROM SCHOOL IF THE ABSENCE IS UNEXCUSED BY
- 21 SCHOOL OFFICIALS; AND
- 22 (2) EACH INSTANCE OF DISCIPLINARY SUSPENSION OF THE DEPENDENT
- 23 CHILD FROM SCHOOL BY SCHOOL OFFICIALS DURING AN ASSISTANCE PAYMENT
- 24 MONTH.
- 25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 26 October 1, 1997.
