3 FOR th	e purpose of integrating, consolidating, and coordinating regulation of health care
4	services and financing under an Office of Consumer Health Care Protection;
5	establishing the Office of Consumer Health Care Protection and the Consumer
6	Health Care Protection Commission; providing for membership of the Commission
7	and requiring members to have certain experience; delineating the authority and
8	responsibilities assigned by this Act to the Consumer Health Care Protection
9	Commission; reestablishing certain existing commissions in the Department of
10	Health and Mental Hygiene to act as advisory commissions to the Commission;
11	transferring certain responsibilities from the Maryland Insurance Administration
12	and the Insurance Commissioner to the Commission created under this Act;
13	creating a People's Counsel to protect the interests of health care consumers in the
14	State; establishing a Benefits Review Professional Advisory Board to resolve
15	disputes involving medical necessity and availability of coverage for health services;
16	transferring certain provisions from the Health - General Article to the article
17	created under this Act and providing for the accurate codification of those
18	provisions; requiring the Maryland Insurance Administration to issue a certain
19	report by a certain date; requiring the Consumer Health Care Protection
20	Commission to study the feasibility and desirability of consolidation of certain
21	commissions and to issue a report and recommendation by a certain date; providing
22	for a delayed effective date; and generally relating to regulation of health care
23	services and financing in the State.
