- 8 government that the county government does not oppose issuance of the permit;

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 18 Article Environment
- 19 9-233.
- The Department may not issue a permit to install, materially alter, or materially
- 21 extend a sewage sludge composting OR STORAGE facility until:
- 22 (1) The sewage sludge composting OR STORAGE facility meets all zoning
- 23 and land use requirements of the county where the sewage sludge composting OR
- 24 STORAGE facility is to be located; and
- 25 (2) The Department has a written statement that the board of county
- 26 commissioners or the county council of the county where the sewage sludge composting
- 27 OR STORAGE facility is to be located does not oppose the issuance of the permit.
- 28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 29 October 1, 1997.
