2 Vehicle Laws - Special Commemorative Registration Plates - Education

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the issuance of special commemorative registration
- 4 plates for any educational commemoration of statewide significance; increasing the
- 5 number of plates that may be issued at any one time; requiring that the surplus
- 6 moneys for each plate issued be disbursed to a Maryland nonprofit organization,
- 7 including, in the case of an educational commemoration plate, a nonprofit
- 8 organization related to the educational theme that the plate commemorates;
- 9 clarifying language; making certain stylistic changes; and generally relating to
- 10 special commemorative registration plates.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article - Transportation**

- 20 (a) The Administration may issue special commemorative original or substitute
- 21 registration plates for any EDUCATIONAL, geographical, historical, natural resource, or
- 22 environmental commemoration of statewide significance.
- 23 (b) The owner of a vehicle, or a lessee of the vehicle under a lease not intended as
- 24 security, or a director, officer, employee, or partner of a business entity that owns the
- 25 vehicle considered eligible by the Administration may apply to the Administration for the
- 26 assignment of a commemorative registration plate under this section if the vehicle is
- 27 included in one of the following classes:
- 28 (1) A Class A (passenger) vehicle;
- 29 (2) A Class B (for hire) vehicle;

1 2	(3) A Class E (truck) vehicle with a manufacturer's rated capacity of one ton or less;
3	(4) A Class G (trailer) vehicle; or
4	(5) A Class M (multipurpose) vehicle.
	(c) (1) [An original] ORIGINAL or substitute commemorative [plate] PLATES may [only] be issued under this section ONLY for a fixed period of 2 consecutive years after [its] THEIR initial issuance.
8 9	(2) The Administration may [only] issue ONLY [1] TWO commemorative [plate] PLATES under this section at any one time.
12	(d) (1) In addition to the annual registration fee otherwise required under this title, an owner of a vehicle assigned a commemorative registration plate under this section shall pay the fee set by the Administration when the new registration plates are issued to the vehicle under this section.
14 15	(2) (i) The Administration shall set the fee at a level that will enable the Administration to recover its costs under this section.
16 17	(ii) The Administration may charge a fee that is sufficient to result in a surplus after costs are subtracted.
	(iii) The Administration shall retain a portion of the fee that is sufficient to allow the Administration to recover any costs of issuing and distributing commemorative plates under this section.
	(iv) Any surplus moneys remaining after the Administration has recovered the costs of issuing a commemorative plate under this section may not be retained by or transferred to any agency of the State for any purpose.
24 25	(v) Notwithstanding subparagraph (iv) of this paragraph, the surplus moneys may be retained for the purpose described in paragraph (3) of this subsection.
26 27	(3) The surplus moneys FOR EACH PLATE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION shall be disbursed by the Administration to a MARYLAND nonprofit organization that is:
28 29	(i) Closely related to the EDUCATIONAL, geographical, historical, natural resource, or environmental theme which the plate commemorates; and
30 31	(ii) Designated by the Administration under subsection (e) of this section.
	(4) No portion of the fee may be credited to the Gasoline and Motor Vehicle Revenue Account for distribution under § 8-403 or § 8-404 of the Transportation Article.
	(e) (1) The Administration shall adopt regulations not inconsistent with the Maryland Vehicle Law to govern the issuance of special registration plates under this section.

3	(2) Before designating any nonprofit organization to receive any surplus moneys and before distributing any surplus moneys to any nonprofit organization, the Administration shall adopt regulations specific to each new commemorative plate detailing:
5 6	(i) The name and nature of the nonprofit organization receiving the money;
	(ii) The relationship of the nonprofit organization to the EDUCATIONAL, geographical, historical, natural resource, or environmental theme which the plate commemorates; and
10	(iii) The plan of distribution of the funds.
	(f) The additional fee to the annual registration fee required by this section is not required for special registration of a vehicle that is exempt under § 13-903 of this title, or a vehicle with a special registration plate recognizing:
14	(1) The Maryland National Guard; or
15 16	(2) A volunteer fire department, volunteer rescue squad, or volunteer ambulance company in this State.
17 18	(g) (1) A special registration number as specified by the Administration and assigned under this section may consist of:
19	(i) Any combination of:
20	1. Letters; and
21	2. Numerals; and
	(ii) Any design approved by the Administration that adequately reflects the EDUCATIONAL, geographical, historical, natural resource, or environmental theme which the plate commemorates.
25 26	(2) A special registration number or design assigned under this section shall be displayed on the registration plates for the vehicle.
27	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
