A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City - Distribution of Lottery Proceeds**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Lottery Agency to distribute certain lottery  
4 proceeds from ticket sales in Baltimore City to the Baltimore City Public School  
5 System and the Baltimore City Police Department; requiring that the Baltimore City  
6 Public School System and the Baltimore City Police Department share equally the  
7 proceeds; requiring that the Baltimore City Public School System use the proceeds  
8 that are distributed to it for certain purposes; specifying that the proceeds  
9 distributed under this Act are intended to provide additional revenue for the  
10 Baltimore City Public School System and the Baltimore City Police Department and  
11 may not supplant other funds allocated to education or public safety purposes in  
12 Baltimore City; and generally relating to the distribution of lottery proceeds to the  
13 Baltimore City Public School System and the Baltimore City Police Department.

24 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
25 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

26 **Article - State Government**

27 9-120.

28 (b) (1) Promptly after the 1st day of each month, the Comptroller shall pay:

29 (i) into the Maryland Stadium Facilities Fund the money that remains  
30 in the State Lottery Fund from the proceeds of the sports lotteries conducted for the

1 benefit of the Maryland Stadium Authority, after the distribution under subsection (a) of  
2 this section; [and]

3 (II) SUBJECT TO § 9-120.2 OF THIS SUBTITLE, TO THE BALTIMORE  
4 CITY PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM AND THE BALTIMORE CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT, AN  
5 AGGREGATE AMOUNT TOTALING ALL OF THE PROCEEDS FROM THE SALE OF STATE  
6 LOTTERY TICKETS IN BALTIMORE CITY THAT REMAINS IN THE STATE LOTTERY  
7 FUND AFTER THE DISTRIBUTION UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION; AND

8 [(ii)] (III) into the General Fund of the State the money that remains in  
9 the State Lottery Fund from the proceeds of all other lotteries after the [distribution]  
10 DISTRIBUTIONS under subsection (a) of this section AND ITEM (II) OF THIS  
11 PARAGRAPH.

12 (2) The money paid into the General Fund under this subsection is available  
13 in the fiscal year in which the money accumulates in the State Lottery Fund.

15 (A) THE BALTIMORE CITY PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM AND THE BALTIMORE  
16 CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT SHALL SHARE EQUALLY THE PROCEEDS FROM THE SALE  
17 OF STATE LOTTERY TICKETS IN BALTIMORE CITY TO WHICH THEY ARE ENTITLED  
18 UNDER § 9-120(B)(1)(II) OF THIS SUBTITLE.

19 (B) THE BALTIMORE CITY PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM SHALL USE THE MONEY  
20 DISTRIBUTED TO IT UNDER § 9-120(B)(1)(II) OF THIS SUBTITLE FOR:

21 (1) CLASSROOM AIDES AND STUDENT SUPPORT STAFF; AND

22 (2) INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS.

23 (C) A DISTRIBUTION UNDER § 9-120(B)(1)(II) OF THIS SUBTITLE IS INTENDED  
24 TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL REVENUE FOR THE BALTIMORE CITY PUBLIC SCHOOL  
25 SYSTEM AND THE BALTIMORE CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT AND MAY NOT SUPPLANT  
26 ANY OTHER FUNDS ALLOCATED TO EDUCATION OR PUBLIC SAFETY PURPOSES IN  
27 BALTIMORE CITY.

28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
29 July 1, 1997.
