- 17 (A) The driver of a vehicle may not stop, stand, or park the vehicle on any 18 vehicular crossing, OR HIGHWAY, except:
- 19 (1) If necessary to avoid injury or damage to any person or property;
- 20 (2) In compliance with the lawful direction of an authorized employee of the 21 vehicular crossing;
- 22 (3) At a designated area for the transaction of business at an administration
- 23 building; or
- 24 (4) If the vehicle is disabled or involved in an accident, in which case the
- 25 vehicle shall be moved, if possible:
- 26 (i) To the shoulder of the roadway;
- 27 (ii) Adjacent to the emergency walkway on a bridge; or

- 2 (B) (1) THE MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY MAY ADOPT
- 3 REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE REMOVAL OF VEHICLES LEFT UNATTENDED ON
- 4 ANY VEHICULAR CROSSING OR HIGHWAY UNDER ITS JURISDICTION.
