2 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
3 (2) "Barbecue grill" means equipment used for outdoor cooking that uses 4 electricity or the burning of charcoal, liquid propane gas, or other fuel for its heat source.
5 (3) (i) "Residential dwelling" means a building or portion of a building 6 that provides living or sleeping facilities for 1 or more individuals.
7 (ii) "Residential dwelling" includes a multifamily residential dwelling 8 hotel, motel, boardinghouse, lodging house, rooming house, inn, club, or dormitory.
9 (iii) "Residential dwelling" does not include:
10 1. A single family residential dwelling; or
2. A multifamily residential dwelling arranged in a rowhouse format in which dwelling units are side by side and none are superimposed above another.
13 (b) In Charles County AND IN WICOMICO COUNTY, a person may not use a 14 barbecue grill for outdoor cooking:
15 (1) On a balcony of a residential dwelling; and
16 (2) Within 20 feet of any part, including a balcony, of a residential dwelling.
17 (c) Penalties for violation of this subtitle shall be in accordance with § 13 of this
