10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
12 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

14 (b) (1) This subsection applies only in Allegany County.
15 (2) The Director of Finance is the local collecting agent. The Director of
16 Finance shall remit and pay to each incorporated town or city in the County 50 percent of
17 the license fees received for the licenses that are issued for the places of business located
18 within the corporate limits of the respective town or city.
19 (3) (i) The chairman of the Board of License Commissioners shall submit
20 to the Director of Finance the total amount of the Board's budget, including:
21 1. Salaries for the Board members;

1	2. Salaries for such other employees as the Board deems

3	3. All other necessary expenses.
4	(ii) From the receipts, the County Commissioners shall pay:
5	1. The salaries of the Board of License Commissioners and its
-	mployees [on a semimonthly basis] ONCE EVERY 2 WEEKS; and
7	2. The expenses of the Board of License Commissioners upon
8 dr	raft properly signed by the chairman of the Board.
9	(iii) The salaries and expenses of the employees of the Board shall be
