13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 Article - Insurance

16 20-515.

(a) The Fund may use the Maryland Tax Refund Intercept Program to recovermoney owed to the Fund by a producer if the Fund makes a demand for the money andthe producer does not make payment.

20 (b) (1) If the Fund makes payment to a claimant, the Fund is subrogated to the 21 rights of the claimant against a responsible party and is entitled to recover all money that 22 the Fund paid out and actual collection costs, including reasonable attorney's fees. 2

- 1 (2) The Fund may recover FROM ITS INSUREDS ALL PAST-DUE
- 2 PREMIUMS AND from the responsible party all money that the Fund paid out under this
- 3 subtitle in any manner provided by law, including the Maryland Tax Refund Intercept
- 4 Program.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 1997.
