# 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

# 13 Article - Insurance

- 15 (f) (1) "Health benefit plan" means:
- 16 (i) a policy or certificate for hospital or medical benefits;
- 17 (ii) a nonprofit health service plan; or
- 18 (iii) a health maintenance organization subscriber or group master

19 contract.

- 20 (2) "Health benefit plan" includes a policy or certificate for hospital or
- 21 medical benefits THAT COVERS RESIDENTS OF THIS STATE WHO ARE ELIGIBLE
- 22 EMPLOYEES AND that is issued through:

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1 2 anoth	(I) a multiple employer trust or association located in this State or her state [and that covers residents of this State who are eligible employees]; OR
	(II) A PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYER ORGANIZATION, COEMPLOYER, OTHER ORGANIZATION LOCATED IN THIS STATE OR ANOTHER STATE THAT AGES IN EMPLOYEE LEASING.

13	(vi) long-term care insurance;
14	(vii) disability income insurance;
15	(viii) coverage issued as a supplement to liability insurance;
16	(ix) workers' compensation or similar insurance;
17	(x) disease-specific insurance;
18	(xi) automobile medical payment insurance;
19	(xii) dental insurance; or
20	(xiii) vision insurance.
21	(m) "Small employer" means:
22	(1) an employer described in § 15-1203 of this subtitle; OR
25 <u>IN E</u>	(2) AN ENTITY THAT LEASES EMPLOYEES FROM A PROFESSIONAL PLOYER ORGANIZATION, COEMPLOYER, OR OTHER ORGANIZATION ENGAGED EMPLOYEE LEASING AND THAT OTHERWISE MEETS THE DESCRIPTION OF § 203 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
