- 2 (e) (1) Laurel Race Course, a track where racing is conducted by the State Fair
- 3 Society, or Rosecroft Raceway may be a receiving track only if live racing was held there
- 4 in the previous calendar year on at least 75% of the racing days available to it.
- 5 (2) [Delmarva] OCEAN Downs may be a receiving track only if at least 6 [65] 40 days of live racing were held there in the previous calendar year.
- o [03] 40 days of five facing were field there in the previous calcular year.
- 7 (3) Pimlico Race Course may be a receiving track only if at least 90 days of 8 live racing were held there in the previous calendar year.
- 9 (4) The Commission may waive a requirement of this subsection if the 10 receiving track could not meet the requirement because of:
- 11 (i) an act of God; or
- 12 (ii) what the Commission finds to be an emergency.
- 13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 14 June 1, 1997.
