SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 (b) (1) There is a Sport Fisheries Advisory Commission in the Department.	
16 (2) The Commission shall provide the Department advice on recreational 17 fisheries matters.	
18 (3) The Commission is composed of [9] 12 members appointed and serving 19 in accordance with the provisions of § 1-102(c) of this article. The experience and 20 backgrounds of Commission members shall represent the diversified angling interests and 21 waters of the State.

3	(ii) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
