If two of the sections each receive the same number of votes, thereby creating a tie, and the third section did not receive the largest number of votes, there shall be a special runoff referendum within 30 days. The cost of the runoff referendum, if any, shall be paid by the County Council of Anne Arundel County. The section that receives the larger number of votes at the runoff referendum shall become effective on the 30th day following the official canvass of votes for the runoff referendum.
