- 17 PRIVATE REVIEW AGENT MAY NOT RETROSPECTIVELY RENDER AN ADVERSE
- 18 DECISION FOR SERVICES DETERMINED TO BE MEDICALLY NECESSARY BY A
- 19 PATIENT'S ATTENDING PHYSICIAN IF THE ATTENDING PHYSICIAN IS EMPLOYED BY,
- 20 UNDER CONTRACT WITH, OR ACTING ON BEHALF OF THE ENTITY FOR WHOM THE
- 21 PRIVATE REVIEW AGENT IS PERFORMING UTILIZATION REVIEW SERVICES.
