A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Howard County - Alcoholic Beverages**
3 **(Alcohol Awareness)**
4 **Ho. Co. 5-97**

5 FOR the purpose of including Howard County with the jurisdiction that requires that an
6 alcoholic beverages licensee or a person employed in a supervisory capacity shall be
7 certified by an approved alcohol awareness program and shall be present during the
8 hours in which alcohol is sold; clarifying language; and generally relating to
9 alcoholic beverages in Howard County.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

18 13-101.

19 (c) (2) (i) This paragraph applies only in THE FOLLOWING JURISDICTIONS:

20 1. HOWARD COUNTY; AND

21 2. Montgomery County.

22 (ii) The licensee or a person who is employed in a supervisory capacity
23 designated by the licensee shall be certified by an approved alcohol awareness program
24 and shall be present during the hours in which alcohol may be sold.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
26 October 1, 1997.
