19	(b) (1) If the cost of any school building, improvement, supplies, or equipment	
20	0 is more than [\$15,000] \$30,000, the county board, at least 2 weeks before bids are to be	
21	filed, shall advertise for bids in at least one newspaper of general circulation in the	
22	county.	
23	(2) The county board may name in the specifications and advertisements for	
24	bids the particular make, kind, or brand of article to be contracted for or purchased.	
25	(c) (1) A contract for the school building, improvements, supplies, or other	
26	equipment shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder who conforms to

11 program to facilitate the participation of responsible certified minority business

12 enterprises in contracts awarded by the Montgomery County Board of Education in

13 accordance with competitive bidding procedures.

14 (e) A contract entered into or purchase made in violation of this section is void.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 July 1, 1997.
