## 2 Wading Pools - Safety

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring that a wading pool altered or constructed after a certain
- 4 date have a certain number of a certain type of drains in a certain location; defining
- 5 certain terms; and generally relating to wading pool safety.

- 8 Section 20-501 to be under the new subtitle "Subtitle 5. Wading Pool Safety"

- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 **Article Health General**
- 14 SUBTITLE 5. WADING POOL SAFETY.
- 15 20-501.
- 16 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING TERMS HAVE THE MEANINGS 17 INDICATED.
- 18 (2) (I) "ALTER" MEANS TO:
- 19 1. CHANGE, MODIFY, OR REARRANGE STRUCTURAL PARTS
- 20 OR THE DESIGN OF A WADING POOL;
- 21 2. ENLARGE A WADING POOL;
- 22 3. MOVE A WADING POOL FROM ONE LOCATION OR
- 23 POSITION TO ANOTHER;
- 24 4. INSTALL A NEW WATER CIRCULATION SYSTEM FOR A
- 25 WADING POOL; OR
- 26 5. MAKE REPAIRS COSTING \$50 OR MORE TO AN EXISTING
- 27 WATER CIRCULATION SYSTEM.

- 1 (II) "ALTER" DOES NOT INCLUDE MINOR REPAIRS OF LESS THAN 2 \$50 TO AN EXISTING WADING POOL.
- 3 (3) "POOL" MEANS AN ARTIFICIAL ENCLOSURE OF WATER THAT IS
- $4\,$  USED FOR THE IMMERSION OF THE HUMAN BODY FOR RECREATION, THERAPY, OR
- 5 EXERCISE.
- 6 (4) "WADING POOL" MEANS A POOL WITH A WATER DEPTH OF 24 7 INCHES OR LESS THAT IS INTENDED FOR USE BY CHILDREN.
- 8 (B) ANY WADING POOL CONSTRUCTED OR ALTERED ON OR AFTER JULY 1,
- $9\,$  1997 SHALL HAVE AT LEAST TWO WATER RECIRCULATION DRAINS, LOCATED A
- 10 MINIMUM OF 4 FEET APART.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 July 1, 1997.
