FOR the purpose of repealing the termination of the law relating to the AIDS Prevention
Sterile Needle and Syringe Exchange Pilot Program.

8 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 9 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

10 Chapter 360 of the Acts of 1994

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted. [It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of 3 years from he date of enactment, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.]

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect19 June 1, 1997.
