9 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency 12 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has 13 been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to 4 each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is 5 enacted. [It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of 3 years from
16 the date of enactment, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act
17 shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 June 1, 1997.
