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	CHAPTER	

1 AN ACT concerning

- 2 Creation of a State Debt Prince George's County Maryland-National Capital Park
- 3 and Planning Commission Tucker Road Ice Rink
- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$950,000
- 5 <u>\$250,000</u>, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Maryland-National Capital Park
- 6 and Planning Commission for certain acquisition, development, or improvement
- 7 purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement
- 8 that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; and providing generally for
- 9 the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.
- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 11 MARYLAND, That:
- 12 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 13 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Prince George's
- 14 County Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission Tucker Road Ice
- 15 Rink Loan of 1997 in a total principal amount equal to the lesser of (i) \$950,000 \$250,000
- 16 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided in accordance with Section 1(5) below.
- 17 This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation
- 18 bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and
- 19 delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and
- 20 Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 21 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as a
- 22 single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under §
- 23 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 24 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer and
- 25 first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and delivering the
- 26 bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then shall be credited on

- 1 the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the Board of Public Works,
- 2 for the following public purposes, including any applicable architects' and engineers' fees:
- 3 as a grant to the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (referred to
- 4 hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the repair, renovation, and expansion of, and
- 5 for the provision of capital equipment for, the Tucker Road Ice Rink in Prince George's
- 6 County, the renovations to include enclosing the ice rink, upgrading the heating system,
- 7 constructing an addition, and remodeling the warming hut, together with other
- 8 renovations that are necessary for compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act
- 9 and current building codes.
- 10 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in rate
- 11 and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and when due
- 12 and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years after the date of
- 13 issuance of the bonds.
- 14 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 15 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a matching
- 16 fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either directly or
- 17 indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or unappropriated. No part of
- 18 the fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to
- 19 the effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching
- 20 fund or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works
- 21 shall determine the matter and the Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1,
- 22 1999, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund
- 23 will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and
- 24 the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan
- 25 equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in
- 26 this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified
- 27 by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
- 28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 29 June 1, 1997.
