## 2 Baltimore City - Ordinance Enforcement - Proceedings and Penalties

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing Baltimore City to establish certain fines civil and
- 4 <u>criminal fines and penalties</u> to enforce certain ordinances, rules, or regulations;
- 5 authorizing Baltimore City to establish certain administrative proceedings,
- 6 remedies, and penalties to enforce certain Baltimore City ordinances relating to the
- 7 sanitary conditions of lots, buildings, and public property; providing appropriate
- 8 judicial review of orders or decisions of certain proceedings providing for the
- 9 <u>effective date of this Act;</u> and generally relating to the <del>administration and</del> <u>authority</u>
- 10 of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to provide civil and criminal fines and
- 11 <u>penalties for the</u> enforcement of ordinances, rules, or regulations in Baltimore City.

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19 The Charter of Baltimore City
- 20 Article II General Powers
- 21 The Mayor and City Council of Baltimore shall have full power and authority to
- 22 exercise all of the powers heretofore or hereafter granted to it by the Constitution of

- 1 Maryland or by any Public General or Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland; and in
- 2 particular, without limitation upon the foregoing, shall have power by ordinance, or such
- 3 other method as may be provided for in its Charter, subject to the provisions of said
- 4 Constitution and Public General Laws:
- 5 (48) (A) To provide CIVIL AND CRIMINAL FINES AND penalties for the violation
- 6 of any ordinance, rule or regulations established by the City under or in the execution of
- 7 any power granted by this Article II; provided that no fine OR PENALTY shall exceed
- 8 \$1000.00 and no imprisonment shall be for a longer period than 12 months.
- 9 (B) TO ESTABLISH, BY ORDINANCE:
- 10 (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, ADMINISTRATIVE
- 11 PROCEEDINGS, REMEDIES, AND PENALTIES FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF ANY
- 12 ORDINANCE RELATED TO THE SANITARY CONDITIONS OF LOTS, BUILDINGS, AND
