A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Commercial Law - Tanning Facilities - Disclosure and Notice of Risks

3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain individuals to sign a written statement

- 4 acknowledging certain facts and warnings about the use of tanning devices before
- 5 using a tanning facility; requiring a parent or legal guardian of a minor individual to
- 6 sign a written statement acknowledging certain facts and warnings about the use of
- 7 tanning devices before the minor may use a tanning facility; requiring certain
- 8 language to be included in a written statement required under this Act; defining
- 9 certain terms; and generally relating to the disclosure and notice of risks at tanning
- 10 facilities.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16

- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 18 Article - Commercial Law

20 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 21 INDICATED.

22 (2) "TANNING DEVICE" MEANS:

(I) A DEVICE, INCLUDING A SUNLAMP, TANNING BOOTH, AND 23 24 TANNING BED, THAT:

- 1. EMITS ELECTROMAGNETIC RADIATION WITH 25 26 WAVELENGTHS IN THE AIR BETWEEN 200 AND 400 NANOMETERS; AND
- 27 2. IS USED FOR THE TANNING OF THE HUMAN SKIN; AND
- 28 (II) ANY ACCOMPANYING EQUIPMENT, INCLUDING PROTECTIVE 29 EYEWEAR, TIMERS, AND HANDRAILS.

1 (3) "TANNING FACILITY" MEANS A BUSINESS THAT PROVIDES ACCESS 2 TO OR USE OF TANNING DEVICES.

3 (B) BEFORE AN ADULT INDIVIDUAL MAY USE A TANNING DEVICE AT A
4 TANNING FACILITY FOR THE FIRST TIME, AND EACH TIME AN INDIVIDUAL
5 EXECUTES OR RENEWS A CONTRACT TO USE A TANNING DEVICE AT A TANNING
6 FACILITY, THE INDIVIDUAL SHALL SIGN A WRITTEN STATEMENT ACKNOWLEDGING
7 THAT THE INDIVIDUAL:

8 (1) HAS READ THE WRITTEN WARNINGS GIVEN BY THE TANNING9 FACILITY;

10 (2) UNDERSTANDS THE NATURE AND EXTENT OF THE RISKS11 ADDRESSED IN THE WRITTEN WARNINGS; AND

12 (3) AGREES TO USE PROTECTIVE EYEWEAR.

13 (C) BEFORE A MINOR INDIVIDUAL MAY USE A TANNING DEVICE AT A
14 TANNING FACILITY FOR THE FIRST TIME, THE MINOR'S PARENT OR LEGAL
15 GUARDIAN SHALL SIGN A WRITTEN STATEMENT ACKNOWLEDGING THAT THE
16 PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN:

17 (1) HAS READ THE WRITTEN WARNINGS GIVEN BY THE TANNING18 FACILITY;

19 (2) UNDERSTANDS THE NATURE AND EXTENT OF THE RISKS20 ADDRESSED IN THE WRITTEN WARNINGS;

21 (3) CONSENTS TO THE MINOR'S USE OF A TANNING DEVICE; AND

22 (4) AGREES THAT THE MINOR WILL USE PROTECTIVE EYEWEAR.

23 (D) THE WRITTEN STATEMENTS REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTIONS (B) AND (C)
24 OF THIS SECTION SHALL CONTAIN THE FOLLOWING LANGUAGE DISPLAYED IN
25 STANDARD TYPEFACE, FONT, AND SIZE:

26 "(1) TOO FREQUENT OR LENGTHY EXPOSURE TO ULTRAVIOLET
27 RADIATION MAY CAUSE SERIOUS EYE AND SKIN INJURIES AND ALLERGIC
28 REACTIONS.

29 (2) REPEATED EXPOSURE TO ULTRAVIOLET RADIATION MAY CAUSE
30 CHRONIC SUN DAMAGE CHARACTERIZED BY WRINKLING, DRYNESS, FRAGILITY, OR
31 BRUISING OF THE SKIN, OR SKIN CANCER.

32 (3) YOU SHOULD NOT SUNBATHE BEFORE OR AFTER EXPOSURE TO33 ULTRAVIOLET RADIATION FROM SUNLAMPS.

34 (4) FAILURE TO USE PROTECTIVE EYEWEAR MAY RESULT IN SEVERE35 BURNS OR PERMANENT INJURY TO THE EYES.

36 (5) MEDICATIONS OR COSMETICS MAY INCREASE YOUR SENSITIVITY
37 TO ULTRAVIOLET RADIATION. YOU SHOULD CONSULT A PHYSICIAN BEFORE USING
38 A TANNING DEVICE IF YOU:

1	(I) ARE USING ANY MEDICATIONS;
2	(II) HAVE A HISTORY OF SKIN PROBLEMS; OR
3	(III) BELIEVE YOU ARE ESPECIALLY SENSITIVE TO SUNLIGHT.
4 5 CERTAIN:	(6) ABNORMAL SKIN SENSITIVITY OR BURNING MAY BE CAUSED BY
6	(I) FOODS;
7	(II) COSMETICS;
8	(III) TRANQUILIZERS;
9	(IV) DIURETICS;
10	(V) ANTIBIOTICS;
11	(VI) HIGH BLOOD PRESSURE MEDICINES; AND
12	(VII) BIRTH CONTROL PILLS.
13 (7) PREGNANT WOMEN OR WOMEN TAKING ORAL CONTRACEPTIVES14 WHO USE THIS PRODUCT MAY DEVELOP DISCOLORED SKIN.	

15 (8) IF YOU DO NOT TAN IN THE SUN, YOU WILL NOT TAN FROM USE OF16 AN ULTRAVIOLET LAMP OR SUNLAMP.".

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectOctober 1, 1997.
