12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Health - General**

15 19-712.6.

16 A HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION SHALL REIMBURSE A PHYSICIAN  
17 WHO PRACTICES ORTHOPEDICS FOR TAKING X RAYS IN THE PHYSICIAN'S OFFICE IF  
18 THE X RAYS ARE:

19 (1) MEDICALLY APPROPRIATE;

20 (2) PART OF THE FOLLOW-UP CARE RELATED TO THE CONDITION FOR  
21 WHICH THE PHYSICIAN IS TREATING OR HAS TREATED A MEMBER OR SUBSCRIBER  
22 OF THE HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION; AND

23 (3) TAKEN DURING THE GLOBAL FOLLOW-UP PERIOD GENERALLY  
24 ACCEPTED IN THE PROFESSION.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
26 October 1, 1997.
