- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 14 Article - Tax - General

- 16 (a) (1) The Tax Court consists of 5 judges appointed by the Governor from the 17 qualified voters of the State.
- 18 (2) Of the 5 judges, the Chief Judge and at least 1 other judge shall be
- 19 members of the Bar of the State.
- 20 (3) [Of the 5 judges, at least:
- 21 (i) 1 shall be a resident of Baltimore City;
- 22 (ii) 1 shall be a resident of the Eastern Shore; and
- 23 (iii) 1 shall be a resident of the Western Shore.] THE COMPOSITION
- 24 OF THE TAX COURT SHALL REFLECT THE GEOGRAPHIC DIVERSITY OF THE
- 25 POPULATION OF THE STATE.
- 26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 27 October 1, 1997.
