1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Kent County - Alcoholic Beverages**
3 **(Expungement)**

4 FOR the purpose of allowing the Kent County Board of License Commissioners to
5 expunge past violations of alcoholic beverages laws and regulations after a certain
6 period of time has elapsed; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Kent
7 County.

9 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages
10 Section 16-508
11 Annotated Code of Maryland

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

16 16-508.

17 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN KENT COUNTY.

18 (B) A VIOLATION OF THIS ARTICLE OR OF ANY REGULATIONS
19 PROMULGATED UNDER IT MAY BE EXPUNGED FROM THE LICENSEE'S RECORD
20 WITH REGARD TO THE CONSIDERATION AND IMPOSITION OF PENALTIES FOR
21 PRESENT VIOLATIONS.

22 (C) THE PAST VIOLATION MAY BE EXPUNGED BY THE BOARD OF LICENSE
23 COMMISSIONERS AFTER 7 YEARS OF CONTINUOUS OPERATION BY A LICENSEE.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
25 October 1, 1997.
