## 2 Victims of Homicide - Transportation Expenses - State Budget

- 3 FOR the purpose of providing that the State budget shall provide the necessary expenses
- 4 to transport a victim of homicide from the site of the autopsy or examination to a
- 5 location in the State specified by the victim's family; providing for a delayed
- 6 effective date; and generally relating to the transportation of victims of homicide.

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article Health General
- 15 5-305.
- 16 (g) The State budget shall include an appropriation to carry out this subtitle,
- 17 including provisions for:
- 18 (1) [the] THE fee for an authorized pathologist [and];
- 19 (2) [the] THE necessary expenses for transportation of a body for
- 20 examination by a medical examiner or for autopsy; AND

- 1 (3) IN THE CASE OF A VICTIM OF HOMICIDE, THE NECESSARY EXPENSES
- 2 FOR TRANSPORTATION OF THE BODY FROM THE SITE OF THE AUTOPSY OR
- 3 EXAMINATION TO A LOCATION WITHIN THE STATE SPECIFIED BY THE VICTIM'S
