4 FOR the purpose of requiring a principal of a certain school and the operator or owner

5 of a certain child care center to provide notice to parents, guardians, and staff of

6 certain information regarding certain pesticide applications; authorizing pesticide

7 applications under certain circumstances; authorizing emergency pesticide

8 applications under certain circumstances; requiring the licensee or public agency

9 permittee to provide the school principal or operator or owner of a child care center

10 with certain material; requiring a school principal or operator or owner of a child

11 care center to place certain notices in certain places at certain times and to make

12 the Material Data Safety Sheet available for public inspection; requiring students to

13 vacate a certain portion of the building before a pesticide application; prohibiting

14 students from returning to a vacated portion of the building for a certain amount of

15 time; providing a school, school system, or child care center with certain immunity 16 from certain civil liability under certain circumstances; and generally relating to a

17 pesticide application at a school or child care center.

8 (II) A LIST OF THE PESTICIDES PLANNED FOR APPLICATION, IF 9 ANY, INCLUDING THE COMMON NAMES OF THE PESTICIDES;

10 (III) THE PLANNED DATES AND GENERAL LOCATION OF 11 APPLICATION;

(IV) THE NAME AND TELEPHONE NUMBER OF A CONTACT IN THE
 SCHOOL OR DAY CARE CENTER WHO IS KNOWLEDGEABLE ABOUT THE SCHOOL OR
 DAY CARE CENTER'S PEST MANAGEMENT PLAN; AND

15 (V) INFORMATION FROM THE PRODUCT LABEL AND MATERIAL
16 DATA SAFETY SHEET ABOUT POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS OF AND ADVERSE REACTIONS
17 TO THE PESTICIDES TO BE USED.

(D) (1) (I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS
PARAGRAPH OR PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A SCHOOL PRINCIPAL OR
THE OPERATOR OR OWNER OF A CHILD CARE CENTER MAY AUTHORIZE A
PESTICIDE APPLICATION ONLY ON THE DATES, IN THE GENERAL LOCATION, AND
USING THE PESTICIDES SPECIFIED IN THE NOTICE REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION
(C)(2)(II) AND (III) OF THIS SECTION.

(II) IF THE SCHOOL PRINCIPAL OR OPERATOR OR OWNER OF A
CHILD CARE CENTER INTENDS TO AUTHORIZE A PESTICIDE APPLICATION, ON A
DATE, IN A LOCATION, OR USING A PESTICIDE OTHER THAN AS SPECIFIED IN
SUBSECTION (C)(2)(II) OR (III) OF THIS SECTION, THE SCHOOL PRINCIPAL OR CHILD
CARE CENTER OPERATOR OR OWNER SHALL NOTIFY PARENTS, GUARDIANS, AND
STAFF OF THE CHANGE IN THE MANNER THAT THE NOTICE IS REQUIRED TO BE
SENT UNDER SUBSECTION (C)(1) OF THIS SECTION NOT LESS THAN 48 HOURS BEFORE
THE PESTICIDE APPLICATION.

PROVIDE NOTICE TO THE PARENTS, GUARDIANS, AND STAFF OF THE EMERGENCY

6 (E) (1) EXCEPT IN THE CASE OF AN EMERGENCY PESTICIDE APPLICATION,
7 NOT LESS THAN 48 HOURS BEFORE A PESTICIDE APPLICATION UNDER THIS SECTION,
8 THE PRINCIPAL OF A SCHOOL OR OPERATOR OR OWNER OF A CHILD CARE CENTER
9 SHALL POST AS A REMINDER TO STUDENTS, PARENTS, GUARDIANS, AND STAFF A
10 NOTICE OF THE APPLICATION:

11(I) AT THE PRIMARY ENTRANCE TO THE SCHOOL OR CHILD CARE12 CENTER; AND

13 (II) IF THE SCHOOL OR CHILD CARE CENTER IS IN SESSION, IN A14 CENTRAL AREA OF THE SCHOOL OR CHILD CARE CENTER.

(2) THE REQUIREMENT OF PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION,
 WHERE APPLICABLE, DOES NOT EXCUSE THE LICENSEE OR PUBLIC AGENCY
 PERMITTEE FROM COMPLYING WITH THE REQUIREMENT TO POST A SIGN UNDER §
 5-208(C) OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(3) THE LICENSEE OR PUBLIC AGENCY PERMITTEE SHALL PROVIDE THE
 SCHOOL PRINCIPAL OR OPERATOR OR OWNER OF THE CHILD CARE CENTER WITH
 THE PRODUCT LABEL AND THE MATERIAL DATA SAFETY SHEETS CONCERNING THE
 PESTICIDE TO BE APPLIED WHICH SHALL BE ON FILE AT THE SCHOOL OR CHILD
 CARE CENTER AND AVAILABLE FOR PUBLIC EXAMINATION.

24 (F) (1) (I) BEFORE A PESTICIDE APPLICATION UNDER THIS SECTION,
25 STUDENTS SHALL VACATE THE PORTION OF THE BUILDING OR GROUNDS TO BE
26 TREATED.

(II) EVEN IF THE ONLY PART OF A CLASSROOM TO BE TREATED IS
A CLOSET OR OTHER ENCLOSED AREA WITHIN THE CLASSROOM, STUDENTS SHALL
VACATE THE CLASSROOM.

30 (2) STUDENTS MAY NOT RETURN TO A PORTION OF THE BUILDING,
31 GROUNDS, OR A CLASSROOM VACATED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS

(G) A SCHOOL, THE SCHOOL SYSTEM IN WHICH A SCHOOL IS LOCATED, OR A
