- 17 (a) [(1)] On or before April 30 following the end of a fiscal year, the Department
- 18 of Fiscal Services shall report on the status of the pension system of each county,
- 19 municipal corporation, and special taxing district in the State.
- 20 [(2) The pension system reports shall be included in the audit reports
- 21 submitted by the Legislative Auditor under Article 19, § 40 of the Code.]

- 3 (2) The [Department of Budget and Management] STATE RETIREMENT 4 AGENCY provides.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 July 1, 1997.
