4 FOR the purpose of adding an exception, applicable to cemetery corporations operating
5 in a certain election district in Prince George's County, to the limit on land that may
6 be held by those corporations; and generally relating to exceptions to cemetery
7 corporation land limitations.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Business Regulation**

16 5-201.

17 (a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a cemetery corporation may not
18 buy, hold, or use, for burial:

19 (1) more than 100 acres in the State; or

20 (2) any land within the limits of a municipal corporation in the State, unless
21 authorized to do so by the municipal corporation.

1 (b) (1) In the Spaldings Election District of Prince George's County, a
2 cemetery corporation may buy, hold, or use, for burial, up to 125 acres in 1 tract.

3 (2) In the Laurel Election District of Prince George's County, a cemetery
4 corporation that operated on June 1, 1955, may buy, hold, or use, for burial, up to 200
5 acres in 1 tract.

6 (3) IN THE KENT ELECTION DISTRICT OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, A
7 CEMETERY CORPORATION MAY BUY, HOLD, OR USE, FOR BURIAL, UP TO 150 ACRES
8 IN 1 TRACT.

9 (c) In Frederick County, a cemetery corporation may buy, hold, or use, for burial,
10 up to 150 acres in 1 tract.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
12 October 1, 1997.
