A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages
 (Hours and Days for Sale)

4 FOR the purpose of expanding the authority of the Baltimore City Board of License

- 5 Commissioners to restrict, by regulation, the hours and days for the sale and
- 6 consumption of alcoholic beverages to include the entire City; and generally relating
- 7 to the Baltimore City Board of Licence Commissioners.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 10 Section 11-301, 11-302, 11-303, and 11-305
- 11 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 12 (1996 Replacement Volume)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

8 (ii)] By regulation, the Board of License Commissioners may restrict 9 the hours and days for the consumption of alcoholic beverages.

10 (c) The owner, operator, or manager of the premises or place may not knowingly 11 permit the consumption of alcoholic beverages that is prohibited by this section.

12 (d) The owner, operator, or manager of any premises open to the general public 13 or of any place of public accommodation where any form of entertainment is provided 14 between 2 a.m. and 6 a.m. on any day and where alcoholic beverages are consumed at any 15 hour of the day shall:

16 (1) Register with the fire department and the Department of Housing and17 Community Development; and

18 (2) Comply with all federal, State, and city building, fire, health, and zoning19 laws.

20 (e) Any person who consumes any alcoholic beverages on any premises

21 enumerated in this section and any owner, operator, or manager of those premises or

22 place who knowingly permits the consumption prohibited by this section is guilty of a

23 misdemeanor and may be fined not more than \$5,000 or imprisoned for not more than 3

24 years or both.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 26 October 1, 1997.
