17	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the changes made by this Act to Article 2B, § 9-217(l) of the Annotated Code of Maryland shall remain effective until [September 30, 1997] SEPTEMBER 30, 1998 and, at the end of [September 30, 1997] SEPTEMBER 30, 1998, and with no further action required by the General Assembly, the changes made by this Act to Article 2B, § 9-217(l) shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
