1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County - Alcoholic Beverages**
3 **(Transfer of Licenses - Abrogation Extended)**
4 **PG 302-97**

5 FOR the purpose of extending the abrogation date regarding a prohibition on the
6 issuance or transfer between certain areas of Prince George's County of off-sale
7 alcoholic beverages licenses; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Prince
8 George's County.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,
10 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages
11 Section 9-217(l)
12 Annotated Code of Maryland
13 (1996 Replacement Volume)

14 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
15 Chapter 499 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1996
16 Section 2

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

20 9-217.

21 (l) (1) The Board of License Commissioners may not issue any new beer, wine
22 or liquor licenses that have an off-sale privilege within, or transfer any additional beer,

1 wine or liquor licenses that have an off-sale privilege into the boundaries of the 13th,
2 21st, 22nd, 23rd, 24th, 25th, 26th, or 27th alcoholic beverages district:

3 (i) The 13th alcoholic beverages district shall at all times be
4 coterminous with the Prince George's County portion of the 13th legislative district, as
5 determined by the Prince George's County Board of Supervisors of Elections. As of April
6 7, 1994, the Prince George's County portion of the 13th alcoholic beverages district
7 consisted of:

8 1. Prince George's County election district 10, precincts 2
9 through 4;

10 2. That part of Prince George's County election district 10,
11 precinct 1 that consists of census tract 8002.04, blocks 109 through 113, 119, 121 through
12 123, and 128, being generally north of Engleman Drive and Briarwood Drive; and

13 3. That part of Prince George's County election district 10,
14 precinct 9 that consists of the following census tracts and blocks:

15 A. Census tract 8001.03, blocks 210, 213, 214, 216, 221, 222A,
16 222B, and 226; and

17 B. Census tract 8002.04, blocks 101, 102, 103A through 103C,
18 104A, 105, 114, 115, 116A through 116C, 117, 118A, and 118B, being that area generally
19 north of Old Stagecoach Road.

20 (ii) The 21st alcoholic beverages district at all times shall be
21 coterminous with the 21st legislative district of Prince George's County, as determined by
22 the Prince George's County Board of Supervisors of Elections. As of April 7, 1994, the
23 21st alcoholic beverages district consisted of:

24 1. Election district 1;

25 2. Election district 10, precincts 1, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 11;

26 3. Election district 17, precincts 4, 10, 11, 13, 14, 15, and 16; and

27 4. Election district 21, precincts 1, 2, 4, 5, 10, 14, 15, and 17.

28 (iii) The 22nd alcoholic beverages district at all times shall be
29 coterminous with the 22nd legislative district of Prince George's County, as determined
30 by the Prince George's County Board of Supervisors of Elections. As of April 7, 1994, the
31 22nd alcoholic beverages district consisted of:

32 1. Election district 2, precincts 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, and 10;

33 2. Election district 16;

34 3. Election district 17, precincts 6, 7, 9, and 12;

35 4. Election district 19;

36 5. Election district 20, precincts 1, 2, 3, 6, 7, and 11; and

37 6. Election district 21, precincts 7, 9, and 12.

1 (iv) The 23rd alcoholic beverages district at all times shall be
 2 coterminous with the 23rd legislative district of Prince George's County, as determined by
 3 the Prince George's County Board of Supervisors of Elections. As of April 7, 1994, the
 4 alcoholic beverages district consisted of:

- 5 1. Prince George's County election district 14;
- 6 2. Prince George's County election district 3, precinct 2;
- 7 3. Prince George's County election district 7, precincts 1
 8 through 8;
- 9 4. Prince George's County election district 20, precincts 5 and
 10 9;
- 11 5. Prince George's County election district 21, precincts 3, 6, 8,
 12 11, 13, and 16;
- 13 6. That part of Prince George's County election district 7,
 14 precinct 9 that consists of the following census tracts and blocks:
 - 15 A. Census tract 8005.08, block 210;
 - 16 B. Census tract 8005.09, blocks 201 through 210 and 213
 17 through 235; and
 - 18 C. Census tract 8035.05, blocks 103 and 105;
- 19 7. That part of Prince George's County election district 10,
 20 precinct 10 that consists of the following census tracts and blocks:
 - 21 A. Census tract 8002.06, blocks 101A, 101B, 101C, 102, 103, 105,
 22 108, 109, and 111; and
 - 23 B. Census tract 8004.06, blocks 201 and 215; and
- 24 8. That part of Prince George's County election district 21,
 25 precinct 9 that consists of census tract 8067.07, blocks 101, 103A, 106, and 107.

26 (v) The 24th alcoholic beverages district at all times shall be
 27 coterminous with the 24th legislative district of Prince George's County, as determined by
 28 the Prince George's County Board of Supervisors of Elections. As of April 7, 1994, the
 29 alcoholic beverages district consisted of:

- 30 1. Election district 2, precincts 1, 2, and 7;
- 31 2. Election district 6, precinct 3;
- 32 3. Election district 13, precincts 1, 2, 3, 5, 7, 8, 14, 15, and 16;
- 33 4. Election district 17, precincts 1, 2, 3, 5, and 8;
- 34 5. Election district 18, precincts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, and 9; and
- 35 6. Election district 20, precincts 4 and 8.

1 (vi) The 25th alcoholic beverages district at all times shall be
 2 coterminous with the 25th legislative district of Prince George's County, as determined by
 3 the Prince George's County Board of Supervisors of Elections. As of April 7, 1994, the
 4 25th alcoholic beverages district consisted of:

- 5 1. Election district 6, precincts 1, 4, 5, 6, 7, 9, 10, 11, 12, 15, 16,
 6 18, 19, 20, 21, and 22;
- 7 2. Election district 9, precincts 3 and 10;
- 8 3. Election district 13, precincts 4, 6, 9, 10, 11, 12, and 13; and
- 9 4. Election district 18, precinct 6.

10 (vii) The 26th alcoholic beverages district at all times shall be
 11 coterminous with the 26th legislative district of Prince George's County, as determined by
 12 the Prince George's County Board of Supervisors of Elections. As of April 7, 1994, the
 13 26th alcoholic beverages district consisted of:

- 14 1. Election district 5, precincts 2, 5, and 6;
- 15 2. Election district 6, precincts 2, 8, 13, 14, and 17;
- 16 3. Election district 9, precincts 2 and 5; and
- 17 4. Election district 12, precincts 1 through 14.

18 (viii) The 27th alcoholic beverages district at all times shall be
 19 coterminous with the 27th legislative district of Prince George's County, as determined by
 20 the Prince George's County Board of Supervisors of Elections. As of April 7, 1994, the
 21 27th alcoholic beverages district consisted of:

- 22 1. Election district 3, precincts 1 and 3;
- 23 2. Election district 4, precinct 1;
- 24 3. Election district 5, precincts 1, 3, and 4;
- 25 4. Election district 8, precinct 1;
- 26 5. Election district 9, precincts 1, 4, 6, 7, 8, and 9;
- 27 6. Election district 11, precincts 1 and 2; and
- 28 7. Election district 15, precincts 1 through 3.

29 (2) The Prince George's County Board of License Commissioners may
 30 approve the issuance or transfer of a license into the boundaries of the 13th (that portion
 31 located within the County), 21st, 22nd, 23rd, 24th, 25th, 26th, or 27th alcoholic beverages
 32 district provided any off-sale privileges of the license are permanently waived as long as
 33 the license remains within the boundaries of the district.

34 **Chapter 499 of the Acts of 1996**

35 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the changes made by this
 36 Act to Article 2B, § 9-217(1) of the Annotated Code of Maryland shall remain effective

1 until [September 30, 1997] SEPTEMBER 30, 1998 and, at the end of [September 30,
2 1997] SEPTEMBER 30, 1998, and with no further action required by the General
3 Assembly, the changes made by this Act to Article 2B, § 9-217(1) shall be abrogated and
4 of no further force and effect.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
6 October 1, 1997.
