- 25 (1) Except for transactions under [Subsection D] SUBSECTIONS D OR E of

- 27 employee of Garrett County, may not enter into any contract of sale or purchase to which
- 28 the [county] COUNTY is a party where the amount involved under the contract exceeds
- 29 [\$15,000.] \$15,000 without advertising for bids in one or more newspapers circulated in

- 1 E. (1) THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION ARE NOT
- 2 APPLICABLE TO THE CONTRACTING FOR ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES, CONSULTING
- 3 SERVICES, ENGINEERING SERVICES, LEGAL SERVICES, OR SIMILAR PROFESSIONAL
- 4 SERVICES REQUIRING A HIGH DEGREE OF EXPERTISE OR TECHNICAL SKILLS.
- 5 (2) WHEN PROCURING PROFESSIONAL SERVICES, THE COUNTY
- 6 COMMISSIONERS MAY AWARD A CONTRACT BASED ON COMPETITIVE PROPOSALS,
- 7 THROUGH COMPETITIVE NEGOTIATIONS, OR BY ANY OTHER PROCESS THAT THE
- 8 COUNTY COMMISSIONERS CONSIDER APPROPRIATE.
