A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Veterans Commission - Membership**

3 FOR the purpose of adding a representative of the Pearl Harbor Survivors Association to
4 the membership of the Maryland Veterans Commission.

5 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
6 Article - State Government
7 Section 9-907(a)
8 Annotated Code of Maryland
9 (1995 Replacement Volume and 1996 Supplement)

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Article - State Government**

13 9-907.

14 (a) (1) The Commission consists of the following [25] 26 members:

15 (i) as an ex officio member, the Chairman of the Maryland Veterans'
16 Home Commission; and

17 (ii) [24] 25 members appointed by the Governor.

18 (2) Of the [24] 25 appointed members:

19 (i) 1 shall be appointed from each of the 8 congressional districts in
20 the State;

21 (ii) 1 shall be appointed from the State at large; and

22 (iii) 1 shall be appointed from a list of individuals submitted to the
23 Governor by each of the following organizations:

24 1. the American Ex-Prisoners of War, Inc.;

25 2. the American Legion;

26 3. the Amvets;

- 1 4. the Catholic War Veterans;
- 2 5. the Disabled American Veterans;
- 3 6. the Fleet Reserve Association;
- 4 7. the Jewish War Veterans;
- 5 8. the Marine Corps League;
- 6 9. the Maryland Retired Officers Association;
- 7 10. the Military Order of the Purple Heart;
- 8 11. THE PEARL HARBOR SURVIVORS ASSOCIATION;
- 9 [11.] 12. the Polish-American War Veterans;
- 10 [12.] 13. the Veterans of Foreign Wars;
- 11 [13.] 14. the Veterans of World War I;
- 12 [14.] 15. the Vietnam Veterans of America; and
- 13 [15.] 16. the Korean War Veterans Association, Inc.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
15 October 1, 1997.
