- 7 Commissioners to set by resolution the date and time of a tax sale; specifying certain
- 8 publication requirements pertaining to delinquent taxes in Garrett County; making

# 3 (D) IN GARRETT COUNTY, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL4 SET BY RESOLUTION THE DATE AND TIME OF A TAX SALE.

5 14-813.

6 (a) (1) At any time after 30 days from the mailing of the statement and notice, 7 the collector shall cause to be published, 4 times, once a week for 4 successive weeks in 1 8 or more newspapers that have a general circulation in the county in which the property is 9 located, a notice that the property will, on the date and at the place named in the notice, 10 be sold at public auction.

(2) In Frederick COUNTY, GARRETT COUNTY, and Queen Anne's
[Counties ] COUNTY, the notice shall be published 3 times, once a week for 3 successive
weeks.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectJuly 1, 1997.
