5 to issue a stadium beer on-sale license to the owner of a professional baseball team
6 franchise that is a limited liability company; and generally relating to a stadium beer

12 (1996 Replacement Volume)13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:15 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

17 (a) The Frederick County Board of License Commissioners may issue a stadium
18 beer on-sale license to the owner of any professional baseball team franchise, whether
19 the franchise is a [partnership or corporation] PARTNERSHIP, CORPORATION, OR
20 LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY.21 (b) The stadium beer on-sale license authorizes the holder to sell beer at the
22 stadium in which the baseball team plays its home games only under the following
23 circumstances:

- 24 (1) In plastic, styrofoam, or paper containers on the stadium premises;

- 25 (2) For consumption on the licensed premises;
-
- 26 (3) To persons present at a baseball game in which the licensee's team is
-
- 27 playing; and
-
- 28 (4) From the time the stadium opens for the game until the game ends.

- 29 (c) The annual fee for the stadium beer on-sale license is \$500.

1 (d) Except for a manufacturer or distributor of beer who is conducting business
2 with the licensee for purposes of this section, the licensee may not permit any person to:

3 (1) Carry any alcoholic beverages onto the licensed premises; or

4 (2) Carry any alcoholic beverages from the licensed premises.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
6 October 1, 1997.
